The Schedule:

Important notes for 2016-2017:

Some things stay the same:

- > Students will be provided slings again this year. We are changing the colors so each grade level is easier to identify and the same rules apply as last year. Replacement bags are \$5.00 and must be purchased from BCHS.
- Again we have two handbooks: The BCHS Student Handbook and a Required Notification Handbook.
- > The attendance regulation for BCHS remains the same and will be closely monitored to ensure earlier intervention.
- > The exam process has been formally added to the handbook but will remain the same as last year.

Some things change:

- > Student driver information has changed from last year because of changes in state laws. Those students who wish to drive to school and to purchase a parking permit need to read the information sent home carefully.
- Virginia High School League Regulations (VHSL): The VHSL now requires all athletes to be in school for 4 consecutive periods. Students may only check out and back in with a valid note from a doctor, dentist, or the court. Failure to provide the proper documentation will result in the athlete being ineligible to participate in any practice or athletic contest that day.
- ➤ The Varsity Boys' locker room will be off limits during the school day. All male athletes will be assigned lockers in the regular P.E. locker room until the beginning of afternoon practices or games.
