


You must be at the "Circulation Desk" to check out books unless you log in using your teacher account. (Remember that you will not want to check materials out unless you physically have the material.)




Log in as a teacher to have access to more options.

DO NOT share your login information with students or substitutes!




Click the "Create New Account" tab to create a user name and password. You will need your employee ID number.

(See the librarian if you don't know yours.)




Use your school email address.

Destiny Quest when logged in as a teacher







To place a hold on an item, first click "Details."




Then click "Hold It".



What is a Resource List?


A Resource List is a group of items, organized for a specific purpose, that can be quickly converted into a bibliography or citation list.

You will be able to create resource lists.



Make the list public if you want others to see it.

(Be sure to save your list!)



After you select the list where you want to save titles, you may use "Library Search" or "Destiny Quest" to add titles.



Click "Reset" and "Logout" to end your session and remove your information from the screen.
