BCHS SOFTBALL FIELD PROPOSAL

BACKGROUND: The original proposal to relocate the girls’ softball field at BCCHS has become a solution to water/drainage problems on the Faith Covenant Church property. Two separate issues have become one.

Attached is a summary of School Board agenda, actions and public comments that relate to the girls’ softball field from October 2008 to the present. Also attached is a project history and proposal provided by Jeff Strasser on June 18, 2010.
