- •Bath's dropout rate is typically just below the state average.
- •The number of male dropouts is typically twice that of females.

•Students with disabilities make up a proportional number of dropouts compared to the general population.

•The primary reasons reported for dropping out are Personal, Moved, Max Age & Expulsion
