The VSBA Webinar on Successful School/Business Partnerships will highlight three successful partnerships around the Commonwealth.

First, Page County Schools will share their partnership with VF Jeanswear and the Blue Bell Foundation who have supported the going "green" initiatives in Page County for the electricity program. They will also describe their partnership with five other schools divisions to find ways to introduce new health care programs in the high schools to support one of the fastest growing employment opportunities in the country. Valley Health has provided seed money to start new programs, will create a summer academy for high school students, and provided guidance on what it is they will need from new employees.

Secondly, participants will hear from Roanoke County Public Schools who will share their partnerships with businesses and organizations and describe how they receive support from and give support to community. Through special projects like Pack The Bus, BandFest, and Graduation Live, collaborations with local businesses and organizations have developed into key relationships that connect their students with the Roanoke community.

Finally, participants will hear Goochland County Schools describe their partnership with Luck Companies which is centered on Values Based Leadership. This program has brought in many professional development opportunities for school division staff and has worked to expand the career & technical programs.


