Bath County Schools are currently insured with Virginia School Board CASUALTY INSURANCE Association policy. Mrs. Hirsh said the coverage/replacement values are RENEWAL comparable and might allow increased replacement values. Mrs. Hirsh recommended accepting the proposal with VACORP as it would result in a \$34,000 savings. The proposal does not include worker's compensation.
