We certainly had an unexpected surprise last Wednesday when the residents of The Springs nursing home needed shelter after the sprinkler failure at their facility! BCHS was not our first choice for the shelter, but the VES gym was too cool—and then the power went out there just as residents were being moved. We needed a quickly/easily accessible location, and the BCHS old gym was selected. Please know that the school division, community, The Springs, and a number of involved residents and their families appreciated the assistance you provided that day. Our response was much more than was articulated in the basic sheltering agreement for a room with heat and electricity:
