**SUBJECT:**                      SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT - ACTION

Request for Pre-Labor Day Opening of School

**BACKGROUND:**                      In the past 5 years, BCPS has been closed an average of 13 (13.20) days per year and meets the “good cause” provision as defined by the Code of Virginia by being closed an average of 8 days per year during any five of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or other emergency situations.

**RECOMMENDATION:**                      The Board must certify that the division meets an allowable provision for a Pre-Labor Day opening of the 2014-2015 school year.

**REGARDING:** Pre –Labor Day Opening

The local school board shall submit annually to the Superintendent of Public Instruction certification of eligibility for a waiver of the “good cause” requirements of §22.1-79.1, *Code of Virginia*. Such certification shall be made in a manner prescribed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

House Bill 557 and Senate Bill 253 were passed by the 2010 General Assembly and amended §22.1-79.1 of the *Code*. Effective July 1, 2010, the *Code* now **permits school divisions to self-certify that they meet one of the “good cause” provisions of the Code to enable the school division to open prior to Labor Day**. Section 22.1-79.1 now reads as follows:

For purposes of this section, “good cause” means:

“A school division has been closed an average of eight (8) days per year during any five of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or other emergency situations.”

As of April 10, 2014 Bath County Public Schools has been closed an average of **13 days per year** in the last five years.
