
Summer school was successfully completed on July 31, 2014. We had students from grades 4-7 working on reading and math. All students made progress and there were no behavior problems.

Bath County High School is off to a great start. Our custodians and other 12 month staff have worked hard to get ready for the opening of school.

We are pleased to announce that preliminary data indicates Bath County High School will be fully accredited and meet Federal AYP.

Our current enrollment is 260 students and the master schedule is 75% complete.

We are in the process of installing new lockers and will be resurfacing the gym floor in late August.

This year, Monday, August 18, 2014 will be our annual Back to School Day. We held this event last year and it was a huge success. We are streamlining the process this year in the hopes that all parents and students can attend.

- Orientation for 8th graders will begin at 10:30 a.m., in the auditorium, and conclude at noon. All students must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
 - o During this time students will be given some brief expectations for the year and an explanation of schedules.
 - o Students will have a tour of the school.
 - o The students will then proceed to the cafeteria to:
 - pay class dues (\$20),
 - fill out all beginning of school paperwork, and
 - receive their schedules.
 - Students will then go to the library where they will receive their textbooks and locker combinations. At this time they may put textbooks in their lockers and visit teachers' classrooms.
- Back to School will start for students in grades 9-12 from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Parents must accompany their students as well. 9th through 12th graders will follow the same procedures as 8th graders; however, they will need to pay all outstanding fees including class dues before students will be given their schedules. All checks should be written to BCHS.
