BACKGROUND: Mrs. Rowe has submitted a proposal for fencing for the safety of cheerleaders

To permanently enclose the area used by the cheerleaders during football games with chain link fence to replace the rope cordon we currently use. It will be gated at each end to allow vehicles to pass through. (Diagram attached)


Rationale:
