REGARDING: Pre–Labor Day Opening

The local school board shall submit annually to the Superintendent of Public Instruction certification of eligibility for a waiver of the "good cause" requirements of §22.1-79.1, *Code of Virginia*. Such certification shall be made in a manner prescribed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

<u>House Bill 557</u> and <u>Senate Bill 253</u> were passed by the 2010 General Assembly and amended $\S22.1-79.1$ of the *Code*. Effective July 1, 2010, the *Code* now **permits school divisions to self-certify that they meet one of the "good cause" provisions of the** *Code* **to enable the school division to open prior to Labor Day. Section 22.1-79.1 now reads as follows:**

For purposes of this section, "good cause" means:

"A school division has been closed an average of eight (8) days per year during any five of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or other emergency situations."

As of April 14, 2016 Bath County Public Schools has been closed an average of <u>15 days per</u> <u>year</u> in five years.
