BACKGROUND:

Educational Talent Search - Noreen Mitchell, Counselor

- Institution represented: Dabney S. Lancaster Community College
- Source of program funding: U.S. Department of Education grant
- Targeted population: Economically disadvantaged and/or possible first generation college students (whose parents do not have a four-year college degree) in grades 8-12
- **Goal of program**: For every identified Talent Search student to graduate from high school and attend a two-year or four-year college or technical school to further his/her education

VCCS High School Career Coach – Marsha Keyser, Career Coach

- Institution Represented: DSLCC
- Source of Program Funding: Alleghany Foundation Grant Funding for 2014- June 2018
- Targeted Population: Coaching helps "middle majority" students-the mainstay of the emerging workforceprepare for college and careers. Career coaches offer unique benefits to students, such as direct access to college programs and services, postsecondary faculty, and businesses and industries.
- **Purpose Goal of Program:** Career Coaches in Virginia are community college employees who are based in local high schools to help students define their career aspirations and to recognize community college and other postsecondary programs, including apprenticeships and workforce training, that can help them achieve their educational and financial goals.
