### **School Mission Statement:**

*Millboro Elementary School will be a community of learners in which all members develop strengths empowering them to accomplish their vision and to encourage a partnership with the community at large.*

**Millboro Elementary School** has served as the elementary school for the eastern section of Bath County since 1970 – after the consolidation of the two county high schools. Prior to 1970, the elementary and high schools were housed together.

The present facility was completed in the fall of 1989. It is a very spacious, modern facility with fourteen classrooms; classroom facility for the handicapped; a large media center capable of housing 10,000 books and seating 40 students; computer lab; cafeteria with a seating capacity of 150; a gymnasium with bleacher seating for 400; art room; music room; conference room; guidance office; records room; and administrative offices.

The school grounds have been designed with asphalt play areas, grassy play areas, soccer/football field, playground equipment, tennis court, nature trail, picnic area, baseball field and adequate parking.

**School Accreditation:** Millboro Elementary School has been **Fully Accredited** by the State of Virginia since the 2001-2002 school year. The school has been accredited by the Southern Association for Colleges and Schools since **1975**. The school made AYP this year based on the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001*.
